Prithvipur Abhyudaya Samiti (PAS) is a non-profit voluntary organization registered under the Society Registration Act-21, 1850, India, dedicated to the sustainable development of villages and small towns. The society is putting efforts to make common people especially down trodden, ignored and physically or mentally challenged aware and augmenting their efforts for better tomorrow. PAS intends to help them to get better education and better opportunities for good and dignified living in all respect.

It also intends to bring various forces of social change and social and environmental upliftment to work in a cohesive way for better impact. The PAS will organize workshops, seminars, meetings and cultural events for awareness, education, participatory and sustainable development. The village Libraries and village Chetna Kendras (Rural enlightenment awareness, and dialogue centres) will also be established in each village of the target area's/identified clusters.

We are planning to establish Rural Research, Education and Innovation Centers (RREIC) in each cluster (at block level) to focus on local problems of education, skill development, agriculture, water management, sanitation, environmental health and economic growth with cultural, physical and mental betterment of the rural people.

We believe in people's participation and putting honest efforts for successful and sustained outcome. We are intending to avoid government and foreign funding, until it is absolutely required. We shall largely depend on public support, donations and social business based earnings.

We have a voluntary team of workers who work for the objectives of this society avoiding any overlap of time and work allotted to them on their work place. The members already in other jobs participate only after their official time in the society's activities.
